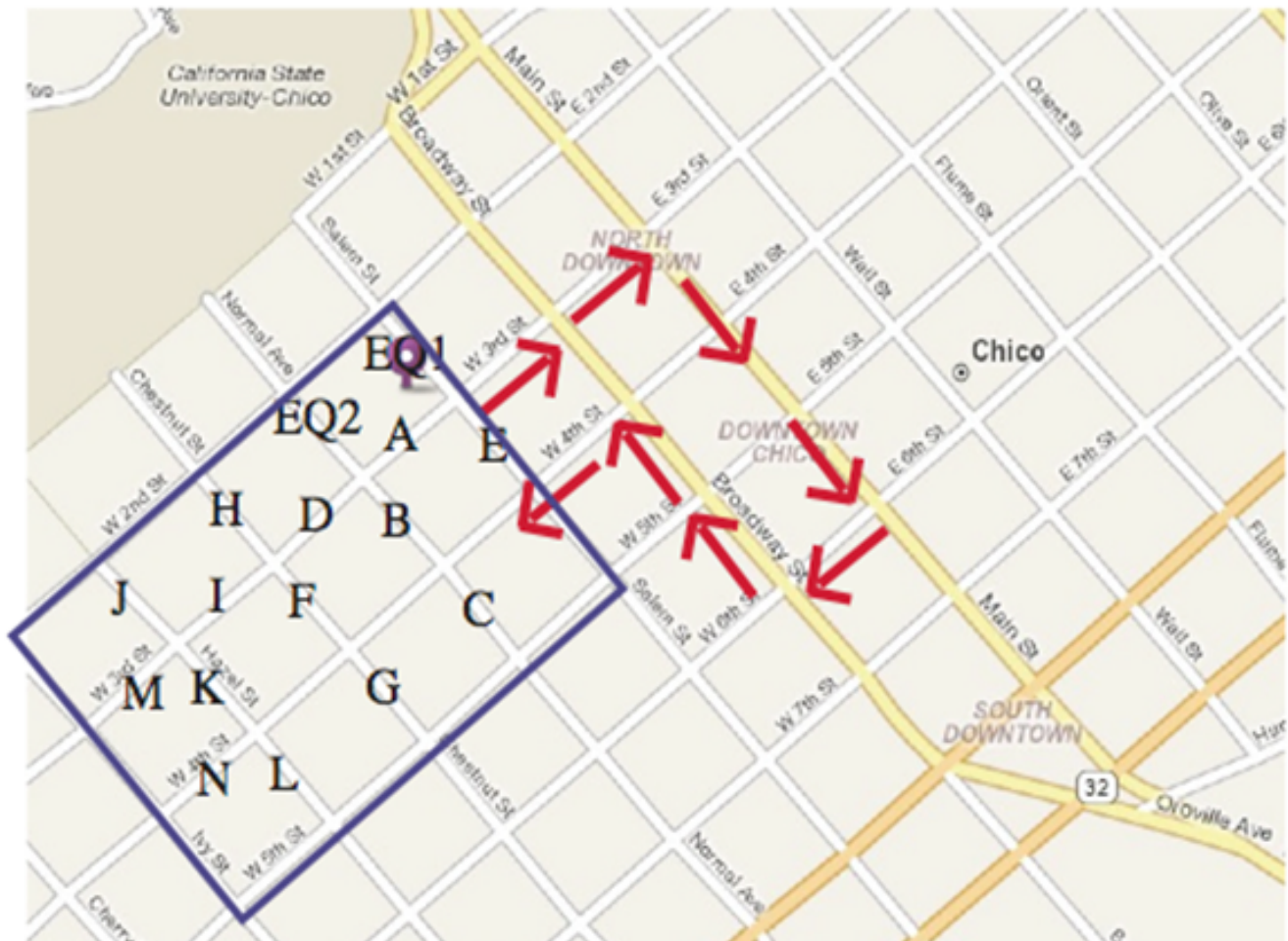

Parade Rules

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARADE DAY:

THE PARADE START TIME HAS BEEN MOVED UP TO 10:00 AM SHARP.

Check-in period will be 8:30 am – 9:30 am, with some changes to ease check-in.

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READ ALL PARADE RULES, some have changed and/or emphasized. Failure to comply may result in removal from the 2018 Parade or disqualification from future parades!

Final instructions, including any additional rule changes, will be emailed to the representative, approximately 3 days prior to the parade date.

1. **NO OBJECTS MAY BE THROWN FROM ANY PART OF YOUR ENTRY!**
This can be very dangerous as children may step out in front of moving vehicles or horses. Members of your entry may pass out flyers, candy or other family-friendly items by walking close to the curb and interacting with the crowd.
2. **NO ALCOHOL POSSESSION OR CONSUMPTION ALLOWED BEFORE OR DURING** the event!
3. **ENTRIES MUST KEEP A CONTINUOUS MOTION** while on the parade route!
No stopping. No gap. No static performance on parade route. Especially in front of announcers or judges stations.
4. Judging will be spread out over the course, on the right side of the Line of March, mostly, but not completely at one of the three announcer's stands.
5. Participants must be appropriately attired for, an all-ages audience and safety.
6. Floats and other parts of entry must be made of fireproof materials. No fire, fireworks or guns, even if loaded with blanks, may be used with an entry. General fire safety rules must be followed! Every float must carry a workable, water-based or ABC rated fire extinguisher.
7. Participants will perform necessary safeguards to prevent injury and property damage from avoidable risks arising from the entry.
8. All animals must be currently vaccinated as provided in State Law and leashed.
9. COP, Inc., reserves the right to reject any entry it considers unsafe or inappropriate for a family-friendly audience.
